## Assignments:

## Tests:

- Tests will be given at the conclusion of each unit of study. Tests dates are announced in class and posted on Google Classroom.
- If a student is absent on a test day, it is expected that he/she will make arrangements with the teacher to make it up.
- Students may retake a test (which will replace the score of the first test regardless of results) if the following criteria are met:
- All homework must be turned in and completed prior to the original testteacher discretion.
- Completion of an alternate assignment will be under teacher discretion.
- Retake tests must be completed within 7 school days from the original test.
- ALL retakes will be done outside of class hours. Please set up a time with me.


## Semester Final:

- A comprehensive final exam will be given at the end of each semester (no retakes).
